A signed BAT AGREEMENT form must be on file for each player on a team before that player is considered eligible to play. If a team is found to have a player(s) playing in a game, who has not signed the bat agreement form, the coach of that team will be fined an amount equal to the player's fee (\$24/\$30) and the current game will be forfeited. If the player wishes to continue playing in the league, in addition to the fine, **a signed bat agreement form must be submitted.**

As a player in Salem Recreation Department's Men's Softball League, I am aware that the Salem men's softball league is an *outlaw league* and that all bats are legal to use in the City of Salem Recreation Department men's softball league.

I understand that I am playing at my own risk, and that the City of Salem Recreation Department/ City of Salem is not liable for any injuries sustained during any games, practices, etc.

I also understand that the Salem Recreation Board will hold open the option of whether or not to ban the use of some bats. Unless there are *extenuating circumstances*, the bat issue will not be brought up again until the October 1, 2009, meeting of the Salem Recreation Board.
