 - (4) Applicants whose applications are approved for an Enterprise Zone incentive will be required to, and be responsible for, making all necessary reports to the State of Illinois regarding incentives received.
 - (5) Any party making a sales tax exempt purchase of eligible construction materials must have their own certificate from IDOR. Purchasers without an FEIN must have an Applicant ID, which can be obtained by visiting http://tax.illinois.gov/Businesses/Incentives/BuildingMaterialsExemptionInformation.htm.
