NOTICE of LETTING**

The City of Salem, Marion County, Illinois, will receive sealed bids for the construction of the project labeled *"SIDEWALK & PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS SOUTH JEFFERSON STREET"* until 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, September 13, 2016 at the office of the City Clerk at the Salem City Hall, 101 South Broadway, Salem, Illinois 62881. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time. Sealed Bids should be labeled *"SIDEWALK & PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS SOUTH JEFFERSON STREET – #P2016-19"* on the outside of the bid submittal envelope.

The proposed work consists replacement of the existing sidewalk and oil and chip parking lot, new curb and gutter along South Jefferson Street and all other collateral work necessary to improve the sidewalk and parking lot.

Bid Documents, including Contract Drawings and Specifications, are available at the office of the Engineer: Rhutasel and Associates, Inc.; 201 South Locust Street; Centralia, Illinois 62801; Phone (618) 532-1992. A non-refundable fee of \$25.00 will be required to obtain a set of the Bid Documents.

Bid Documents, including Contract Drawings and Specifications, are also available for examination at the Southern Illinois Builders Association; O'Fallon, Illinois and at the City of Salem City Hall.

No less than the prevailing rate of wages, as determined in accordance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage, shall be paid to all laborers, operators, teamsters, masons, plumbers, and any other workmen employed in the construction of this project.

Each Bidder must deposit with its bid a security in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the Bidder's total bid price. Such security being an acceptable bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance and Payment Bonds or in the full amount of the bid.

No Bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening. The City of Salem, Illinois, reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities or technicalities in the bidding.
