**V. City Council Action**

- 2. The Council is in a position to appoint the Mayor for the time frame between now and the next general election scheduled for April 2021.**
- 3. The new Mayor will then be sworn into office by the Salem City Clerk, Bev Quinn.**
- 4. Appointment of new Mayor Pro Tem.**
- 5. The City has a need to implement a policy on deterring and reporting Fraud, Waste and Abuse to satisfy grant requirements by ILDCEO. This policy needs to be implemented to avoid any undue delays in the disbursement of RLF funds and future grant requirements. The final form will be available on Monday and will contain the relevant references to statute.**
- 6. Final reading – 2020 Property tax Levy in the amount of 1.0499%. Asking for approval of the ordinance to impose the levy.**
- 7. Request for approval of ordinance to abate the City's levy for 2019 under the General Obligation Refunding Bonds, series 2017 (Alternate Revenue Source) originally issued in the amount of \$2,465,000.00.**
- 8. Request for approval of ordinance to abate the City's levy for 2019 for the Wastewater Treatment Improvements Revenue Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source under ordinance 2015-17 originally issued in the amount of \$3,170,000.00.**
- 9. Request for approval of resolution supplied by the Illinois Oil and Gas Industry to indicate the City's support of the oil and gas industry within the area and the state of Illinois. The Oil and Gas industry in our area provides employment opportunities and generates revenues through sales and real estate taxes and patronage of local businesses.**
