2. **First reading** – The city has received some complaints about members of the community feeding wildlife including deer and other non-domesticated animals within the City Limits. The IL Dept. of Natural Resources has an ordinance against the feeding of deer and other wildlife that replaces their natural feeding habits and creates the potential for these animals to become a nuisance to neighboring animals. The proposed ordinance supports the States ordinance and prohibits the feeding of wildlife other than birds and squirrels in raised feeders. If acceptable the ordinance could be enacted after the second reading to allow time for public response.

3. **Approval of bid letting for oil and chip materials for road resurfacing** – Request approval for awarding of bid prices for the oil and chip materials used to resurface city streets.
