1. Consent agenda – Approval of minutes of the August 1, 2022 Salem City Council meeting. **Recommend approval of the minutes from August 1st, 2022.**
2. The Little Egypt Festival is scheduled for Saturday, October 1st, 2022 and the City has typically adopted a resolution to temporarily close roads along the parade route and set up alternate bypass routes for other traffic. Resolution 2022-05 has been prepared and is provided for consideration. **Recommend approval of Resolution 2022-05 for the Little Egypt Festival Parade and Festivities.**
3. There is someone who is interested in donating an aerial drone to the Salem Police Department for their use in searching for missing children and adults among other possible tasks. The use of a drone would require the “pilot” of the drone to be a licensed operator and follow some regulations set out by the FAA. Mayor Farley is encouraging discussion on whether the City would like to move forward with the opportunity.
